2. NEVER LET OTHERS CONTROL MY

(VS. 15-18)

Critics, Comrades, Competitors, & Conspirators:

Others preach from <u>genuine good will.</u> These do so out of love, and they know God's given me the work of defending the gospel.

Others preach Christ insincerely from a spirit of selfish ambition.

Others just want to <u>stir up more trouble for me</u>, and add to my pain while *I am in prison."* Phil. 1:15-17 (TEV)

PAUL'S ATTITUDE:
